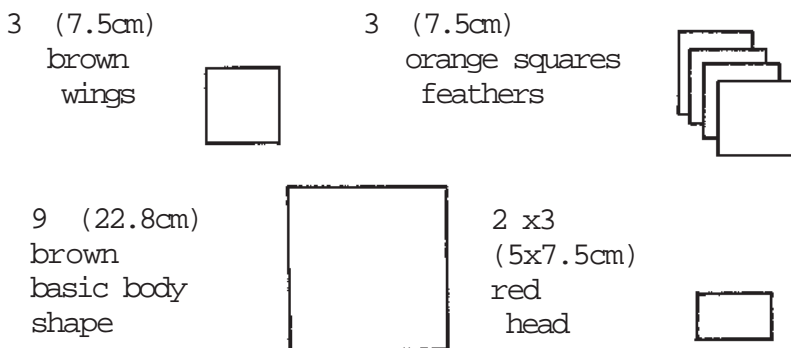
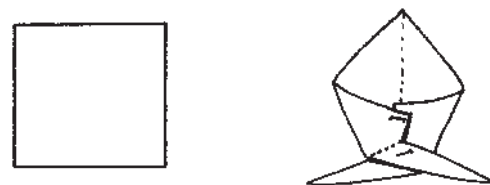
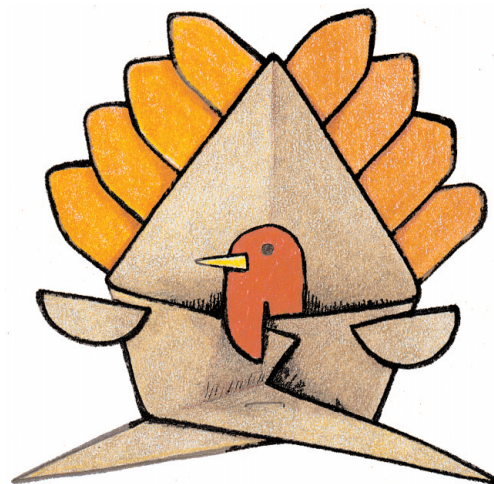


Details for making The Cross-Legged Turkey

- You Need:
1. scissors
 2. glue
 3. stapler
 4. construction paper:



You will also need a tiny scrap of yellow for the beak.

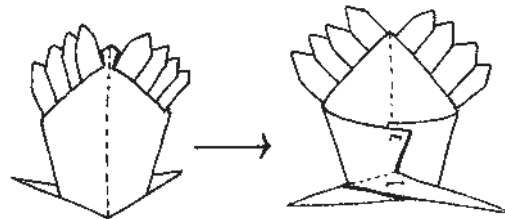
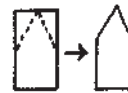


Body

following the directions on page 1, make the basic shape with the big brown square.

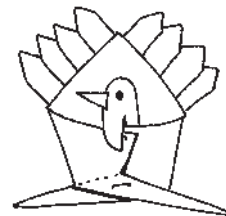
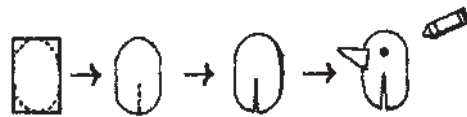
Feathers

1. Fold orange squares, open up and cut in half along the crease. You will have eight feathers.
2. Trim one end of each feather to form a soft point.
3. Paste the feathers on the back of the basic shape.



Head

1. Round all four corners of the red head. Cut a slit about one-third to one-half way up from one end only.
2. Draw an eye with black marker. Turn over and draw the other eye.
3. Glue on a yellow scrap to make the beak.
4. Slip the turkey's head on the basic shape. Hold in place with a dot of glue on the piece of red that goes inside the pocket.



Wings

1. Round the edges of the brown paper.
2. Fold the circle in half. Open and cut along crease.
3. Glue onto the basic shape.
