


Basic Shape for a Cross-Legged Critter


Once you've learned how to create this basic shape, you can then make things like: a turkey, a Santa, a Leprechaun, a bunny--lots of different "critters." Have fun!

- 9" (22.8cm) square of construction paper
- scissors
- ◆ stapler







2. Open up and make two more folds, folding the outside edges to the center crease.









3. Fold narrow, bottom point to meet top point.





4 Open the paper. Cut up the center crease. STOP at the crease in the middle.







5. Re-fold the paper and Cross the "legs."







6. Staple.



7. Put your hand inside and create a little pocket. Now it's ready to hold nuts, candy, notes--let your imagination go!
