A challenge: This model earned this rating because it has many pieces, requires some intricate folds and has detailed instructions.

There are 2 instruction pages and 5 pattern pages.

- The model has 3 major parts: 1st floor, 2nd floor, 3rd floor
- All - - broken lines are CUT lines.
- All tabs are marked "glue tab" but you may elect to use tape on some pieces.
- Only one piece, on the top level, requires exacto-blade cuts.


You will need:

- Two pieces of tagboard 2 1/2" x 7 1/8"
- Scissors, glue, tape, colored pencils or crayons.
- Pattern Pieces (on 5 pages)

Building your Z-house


1st Floor

- 1. Begin with page 1 ~ the 1st floor.
- 2. Color (look at Albert's Alphabet for the colors).
- 3. Cut along all - - broken lines.
- 4. Fold along all "fold" lines.

Glue or tape the 1st floor to the tagboard base.
